




OptVal Function Library: Installation Instructions

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1) The OptVal Function Library is available for 32-bit and 64-bit versions of Microsoft Office. If you are unsure about which version of Office that you are using, open any Office application, open the File menu, and then select Help. Your installation will be identified on the right.






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2) The file *OptVal Setup.zip* is a zipped file containing the installation program for the OptVal Function Library. Click on *OptVal Setup.zip*, and the following screen will appear. If you are running the 32-bit (64-bit) version of Office Excel, double click on *OptVal Setup.msi* (*OptVal Setup 64.msi*).




3) Click on **Next**.






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4) Unless specified otherwise, the program files will be installed in the C:\Program files subdirectory, You are free to specify a different location. Click on Next.




5) Click on Install.






6) Installation is complete.





7) An OptVal icon will appear on your desktop. Double-click on the icon. Click on Enable this add-in for this session only to use the OptVal Function Library for a single session. The OptVal Function Library will then load into Excel.





8) To have the OptVal Function Library appear automatically each time Excel is opened on your PC, open Excel, under the File menu select Options, and under the Options menu select Add-Ins.






9) On the screen will appear a list of active and inactive add-ins that are located on your PC. To activate the OptVal Function Library add-ins, click on the *Go...* button at the bottom of the screen.





- 10) On the screen will appear the box below. Click on **Browse** to link the OptVal Function Library. It is in the folder that you used under step 3) above.



- 11) On the screen will appear a new box that lists the OptVal Function Library. Check the box to the left, and then click **OK**. The OptVal Function is now activated, and will open each time you open Excel.



1 2) To call the functions, go to the Formulas menu, click Insert Function, and select a function category from the menu. The contents of the different categories are listed when the category is selected. The functions in OV Standard options are listed below.
